



HOST RESPONSIBILITY

We have implemented a host responsibility policy because we have created an environment where all guests can enjoy an atmosphere where alcohol will be served.

The management and staff of the event believe we have a responsibility to provide an environment that is not only comfortable and welcoming but where alcohol is served responsibly. Because of this, we have implemented the following Host Responsibility policy.

Identifying event bracelets must be worn at all times, this is your proof of eligibility to purchase alcohol at the pop up bars.

No drinks to be taken outside the event area. 24/7 liquor ban applies outside the event area.

Sober persons purchasing alcohol for intoxicated persons will not be tolerated.

Customers who are visibly intoxicated will not be served alcohol, will be asked to leave the premises and will be encouraged to take advantage of safe transport options.

It is against the law to serve alcohol to minors. If we are in doubt about your age, we will ask for identification. Acceptable forms of proof of age are a photo driver's licence, an 18+ Evidence of Age card or a current passport.

Our policy is zero tolerance for aggressive, coercive or violent behavior.

We provide and actively promote a range of low-alcohol and non-alcoholic drinks, including water that is available free of charge at all times.

We promote a range of transport options to get you home safely.

All of these services are well promoted, along with signage required under the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.
